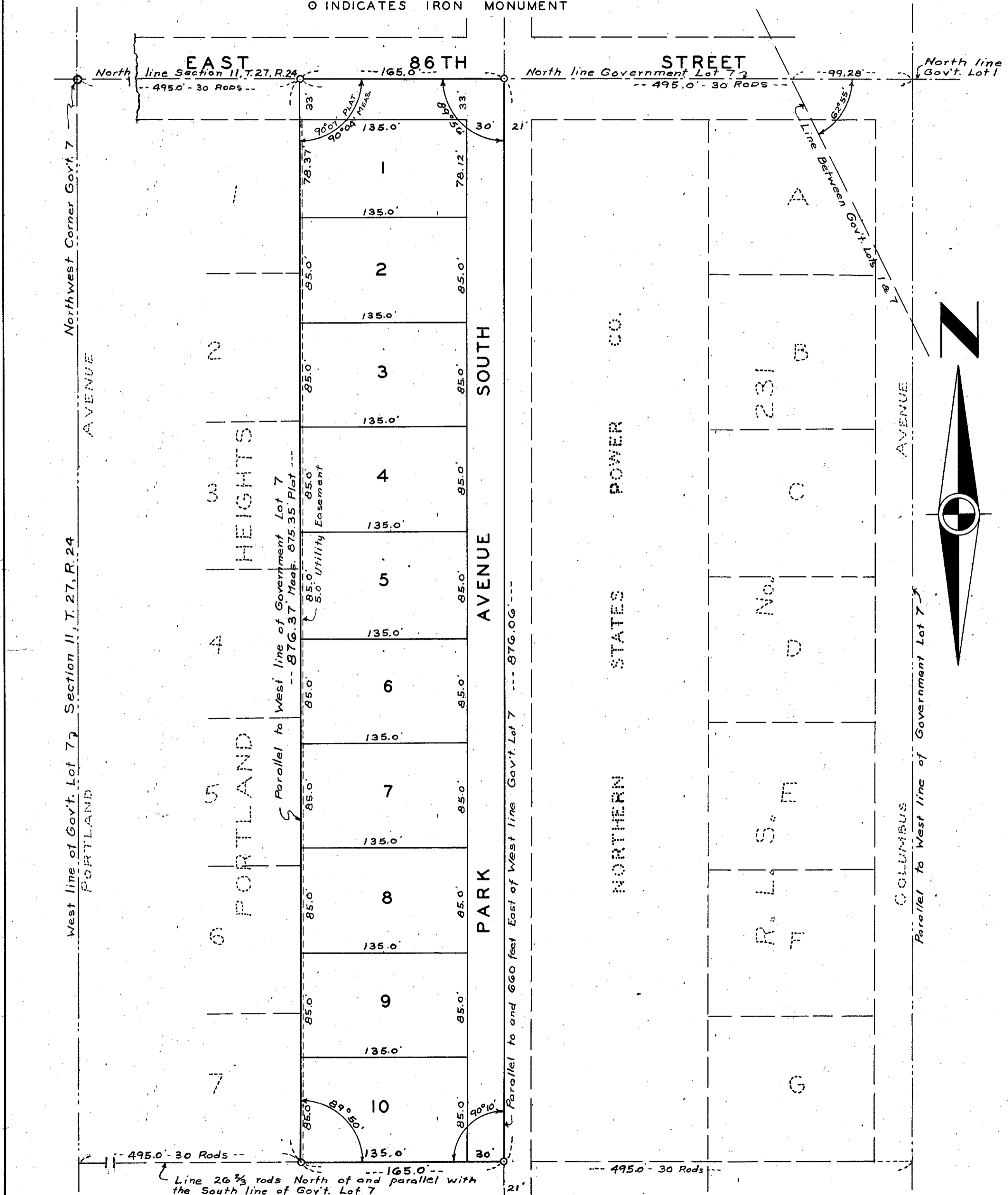


GEORGE BUTLER 1ST ADDITION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Anderson-Butler Construction Company, a Minnesota Corporation, owners and proprietors of the following described property situated in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, to wit:— That part of Government Lots One (1) and Seven (7), Section Eleven (11), Township Twenty-seven (27), Range Twenty-four (24), described as follows: Commencing on the North line of Government Lot Seven (7) at a point Thirty (30) rods East of the Northwest corner of said lot; thence South parallel with the west line of said lot to a point Twenty-six and two-thirds ($26 \frac{2}{3}$) rods north of the South line of said Lot Seven (7); thence East parallel with South line of said lot a distance of Thirty (30) rods; thence North parallel with West line of said Lot Seven (7) a distance of Fifty-three and one-third ($53 \frac{1}{3}$) rods more or less to North line of Government Lot One (1); thence West along North line of Government Lots One (1) and Seven (7) a distance of Thirty (30) rods to beginning, except that part thereof lying East of the west six hundred sixty (660) feet of said Government Lot Seven (7). Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as GEORGE BUTLER 1st ADDITION, and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for the public use forever the streets and avenues as shown on the annexed plat; also subject to the utility easements as shown on the annexed plat.
