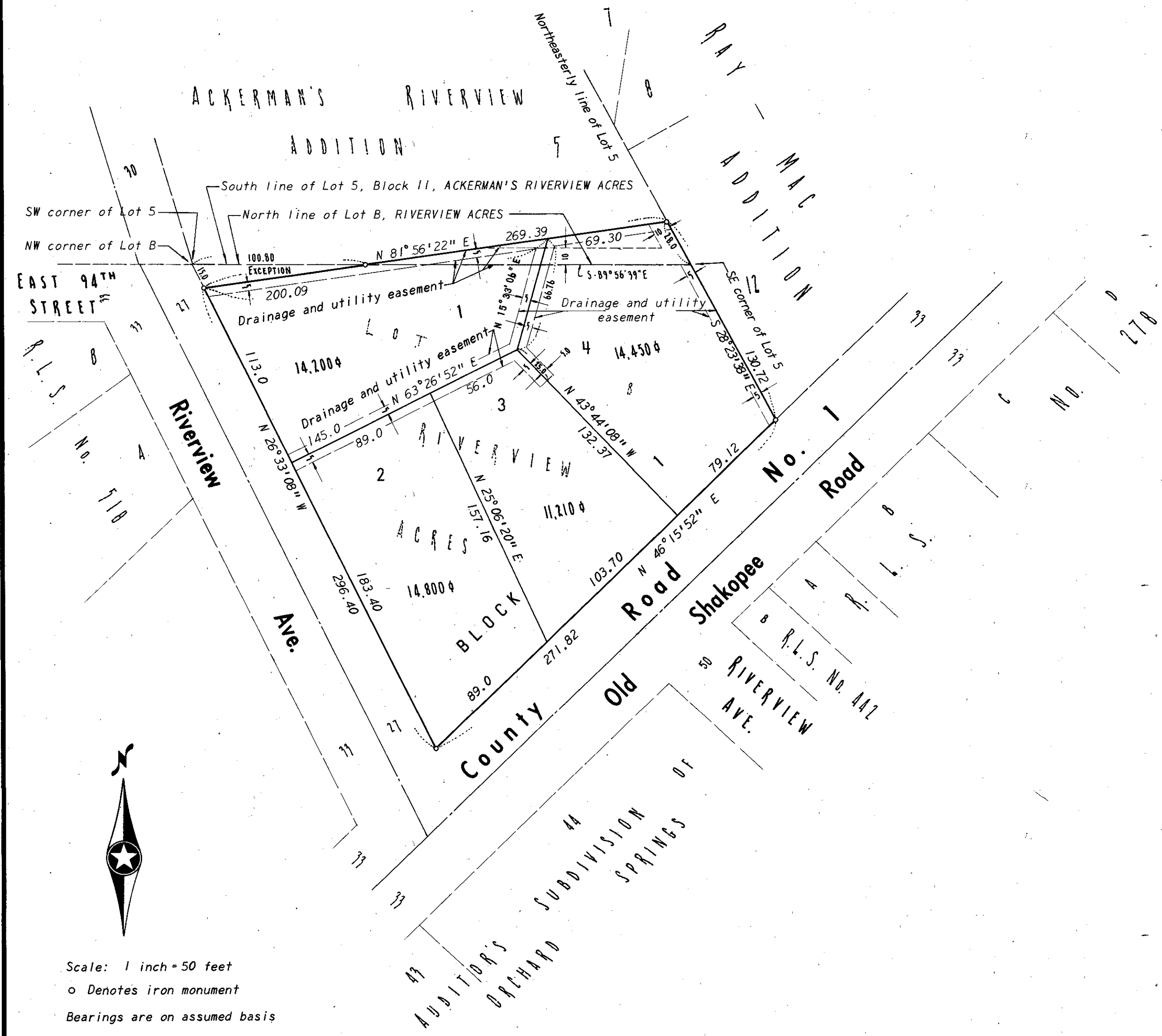


HAASE 1ST ADDITION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Lyle W. Haase and Sarah Ruth Haase, husband and wife, owners and proprietors of the following described property situate in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, to wit: Lot B, except that part lying Northwestly of a straight line drawn from a point on the Southwestly boundary line of Lot B, said point measured 15 feet Southeastly from the Northwest corner of Lot B, to a point on the North line of Lot B, said point measured 100.8 feet East from the Northwest corner of said Lot B, in Riverview Acres, according to the plat on file and of record in the office of the Registrar of Titles in and for Hennepin County, Minnesota and all that part of Lot 5, Block 11, Ackerman's Riverview Addition lying Southeastly of a straight line drawn from a point on the South line of Lot 5, said point measured 100.8 feet East from the Southwest corner of Lot 5, to a point on the Northeastly line of Lot 5, said point measured 28 feet Northwestly from the Southeast corner of said Lot 5, according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Registrar of Titles in and for said Hennepin County. Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as HAASE 1ST ADDITION and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for public use forever the easements for drainage and utility purposes as shown on the annexed plat.
