

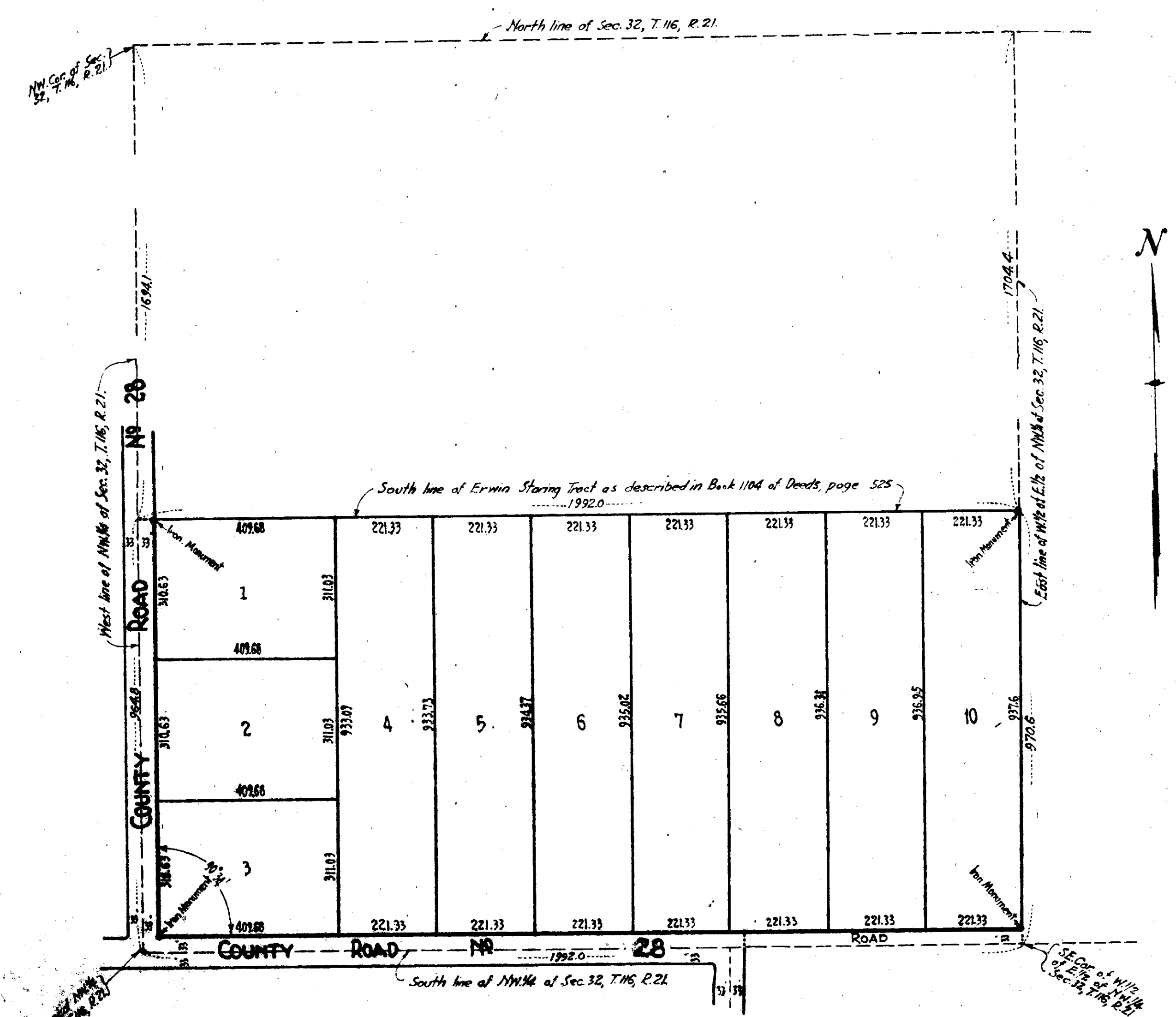
# BLOOMINGTON GARDENS SECOND ADDITION

Know all men by these presents, that I, John R. McLane, Receiver, owner and proprietor of the following described property situate in the State of Minnesota and County of Hennepin to-wit: That part of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One-hundred and sixteen (116) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West of the Fifth (5th) Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section Thirty-two (32); thence North along the west line of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) to a point distant Sixteen hundred and ninety-four and one-tenth (1694.1) feet South of the northwest corner of said Section Thirty-two (32); thence East along a straight line to a point in the east line of the West one-half (W 1/2) of the East one-half (E 1/2) of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) distant Seventeen hundred and four and four-tenths (1704.4) feet South of the north line of said Section Thirty-two (32); thence South along said east line of West one-half (W 1/2) of East one-half (E 1/2) of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) to the southeast corner of the West one-half (W 1/2) of the East one-half (E 1/2) of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4); thence West along the south line of said Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) to the point of beginning, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as "BLOOMINGTON GARDENS SECOND ADDITION, HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA," and I hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all the Roads as shown on the annexed plat. 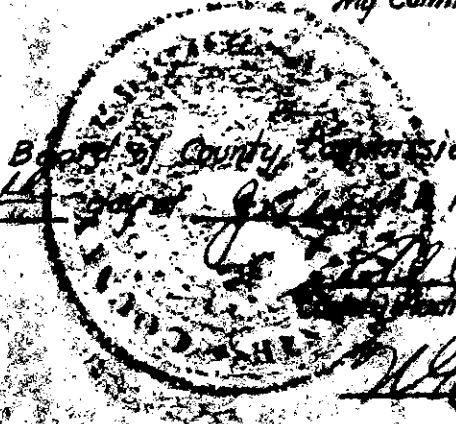
