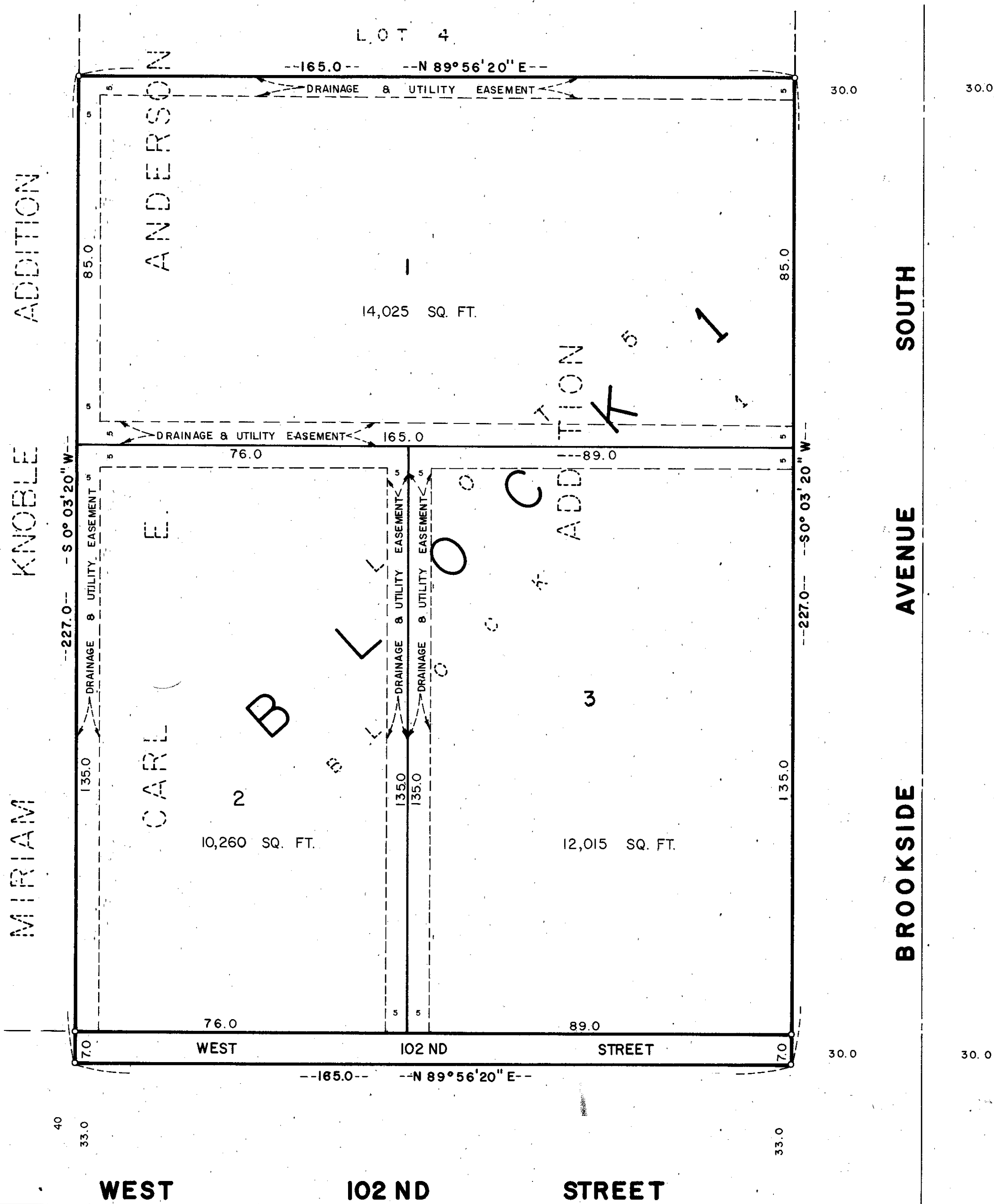


CARL E. ANDERSON 2ND ADDITION

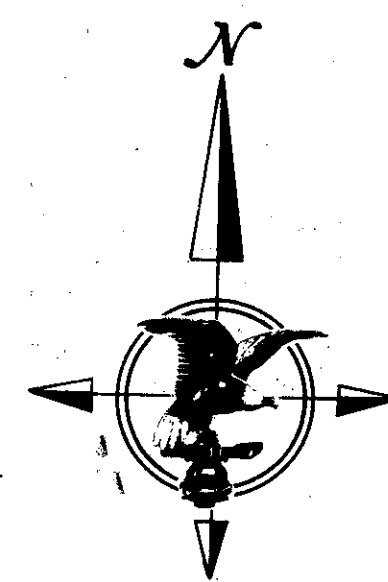
