Bids received after this date and time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud in McLeod Conference Room at Bloomington Civic Plaza, 1800 West Old Shakopee Road, Bloomington, MN immediately after specified closing time. All bids submitted are to be valid for sixty (60) calendar days.

The scope of work for this Project shall include, but not be limited to:

- Concrete slab and exterior decorative concrete work.
- Foundations for columbarium units and site furniture.
- Landscaping

Requests for bid documents must include the company name, address, phone and fax numbers, contact name and e-mail address.

Each bid must be clearly identified on the outside of the envelope as **“BID FOR COLUMBARIA ADDITION”** and shall show the name and address of the bidder. A certified or cashier's check payable to the City of Bloomington, or satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a licensed surety company must also accompany the bid in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted. The bidder shall execute a written contract and furnish the required bonds within ten (10) days after the award of the contract. Bidders must submit a copy of Department of Labor and Industry (DLI) Building Construction Contractor Registration with the bid. Bidders must also submit a copy of the Responsible Contractor Certification with their Bid.

The City of Bloomington reserves the right to reject any or all bids including, without limitation, the right to reject any incomplete, non-conforming, non-responsive, unbalanced, or conditional bids. The City also reserves the right to waive any informalities and to award the contract, in whole or in part, to the bidder the City determines is in the City's best interest.
